Ten students were given a guided tour of the kitchen on the first floor of Campus Dining Centre on 22 April 2017, an open communication with canteen staff has helped students to understand kitchen operation and management. The visitors, wearing white scrubs and hats, were led by the canteen staff to visit the food processing area, cooking area, Chinese and western dessert making area, rice cooking line and tableware washing and disinfecting lines.

The students spoke highly of the scientific management system and advanced equipment. All measures to ensure food safety was introduced, eg: pesticides residue test, dish sample storage for further test, sampling inspection, external food test. Students were impressed by the management system and detail oriented concept. Some minor questions regarding various dining experience was answered by the canteen staff. Those students now have better understanding of the canteen operation at the international campus.

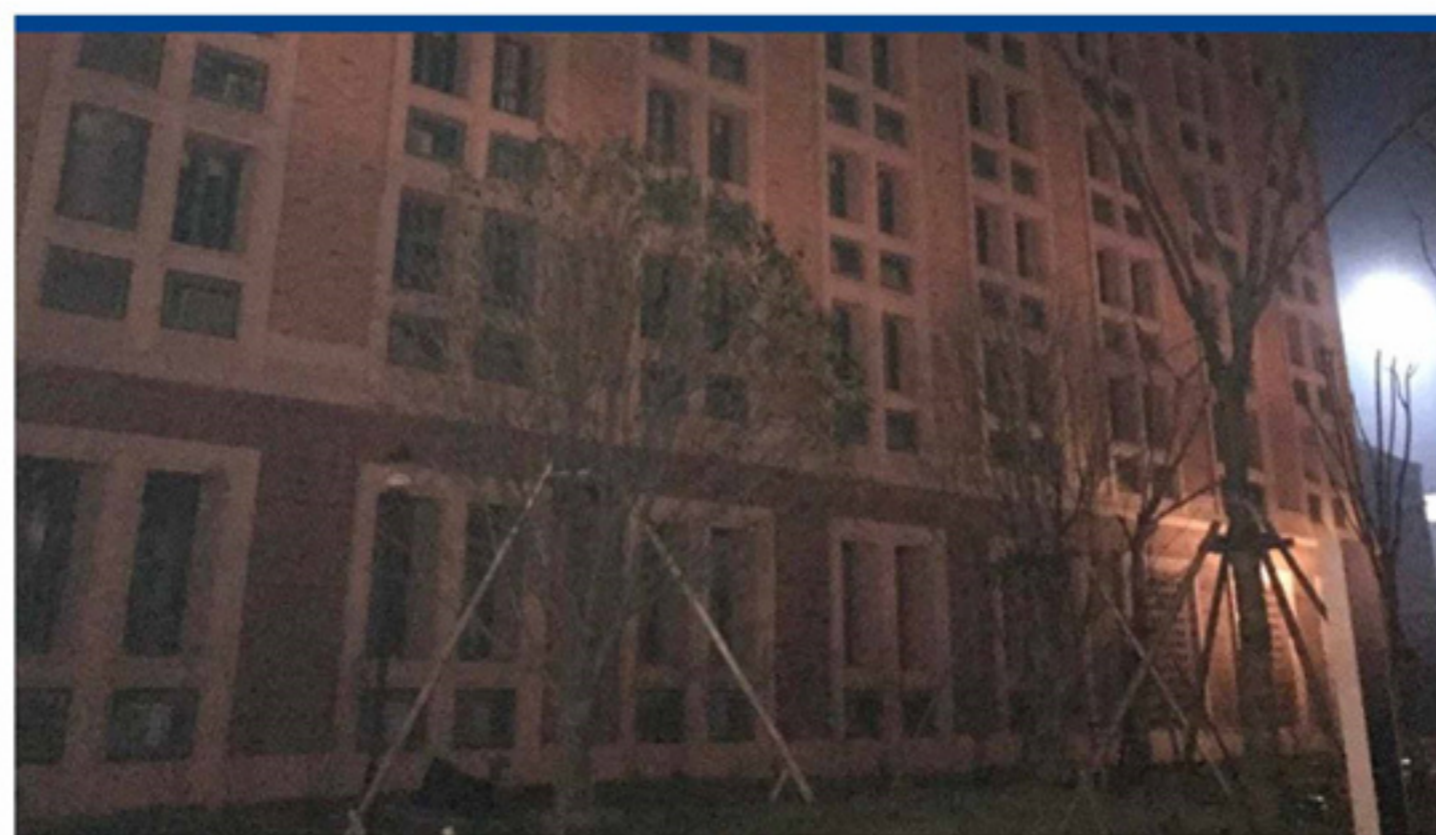
## CANTEEN Here Comes The Vanilla Ice Cream

## Residential Energy-saving month of Residential College



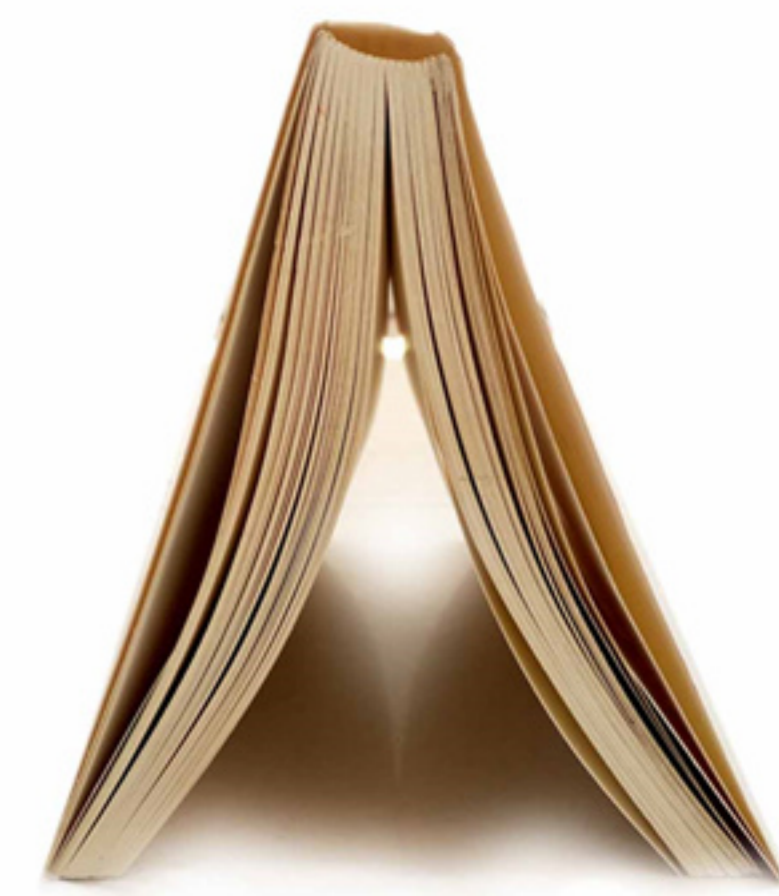

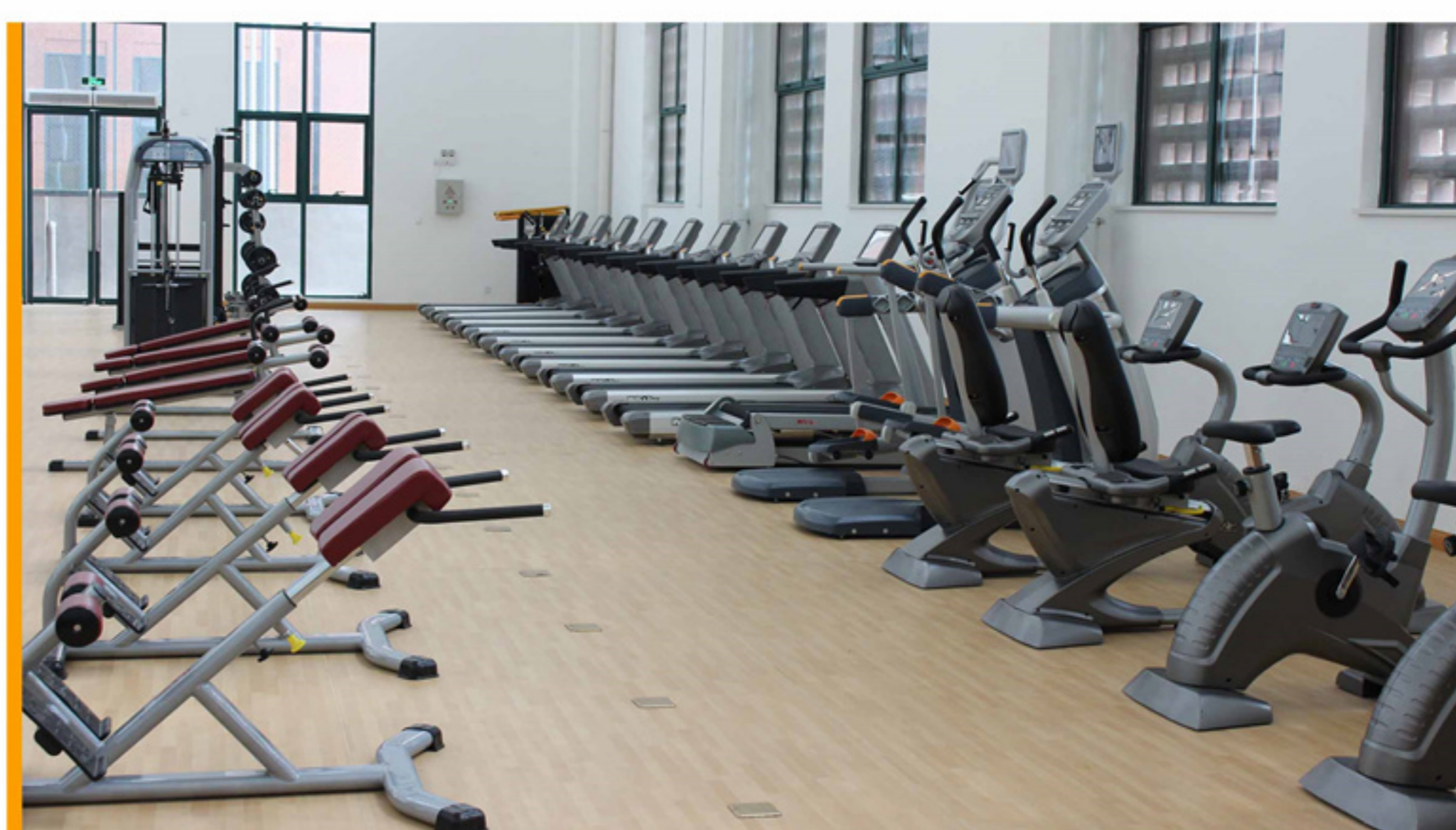

## PHASE ONE Preparation For The Opening of Campus Library

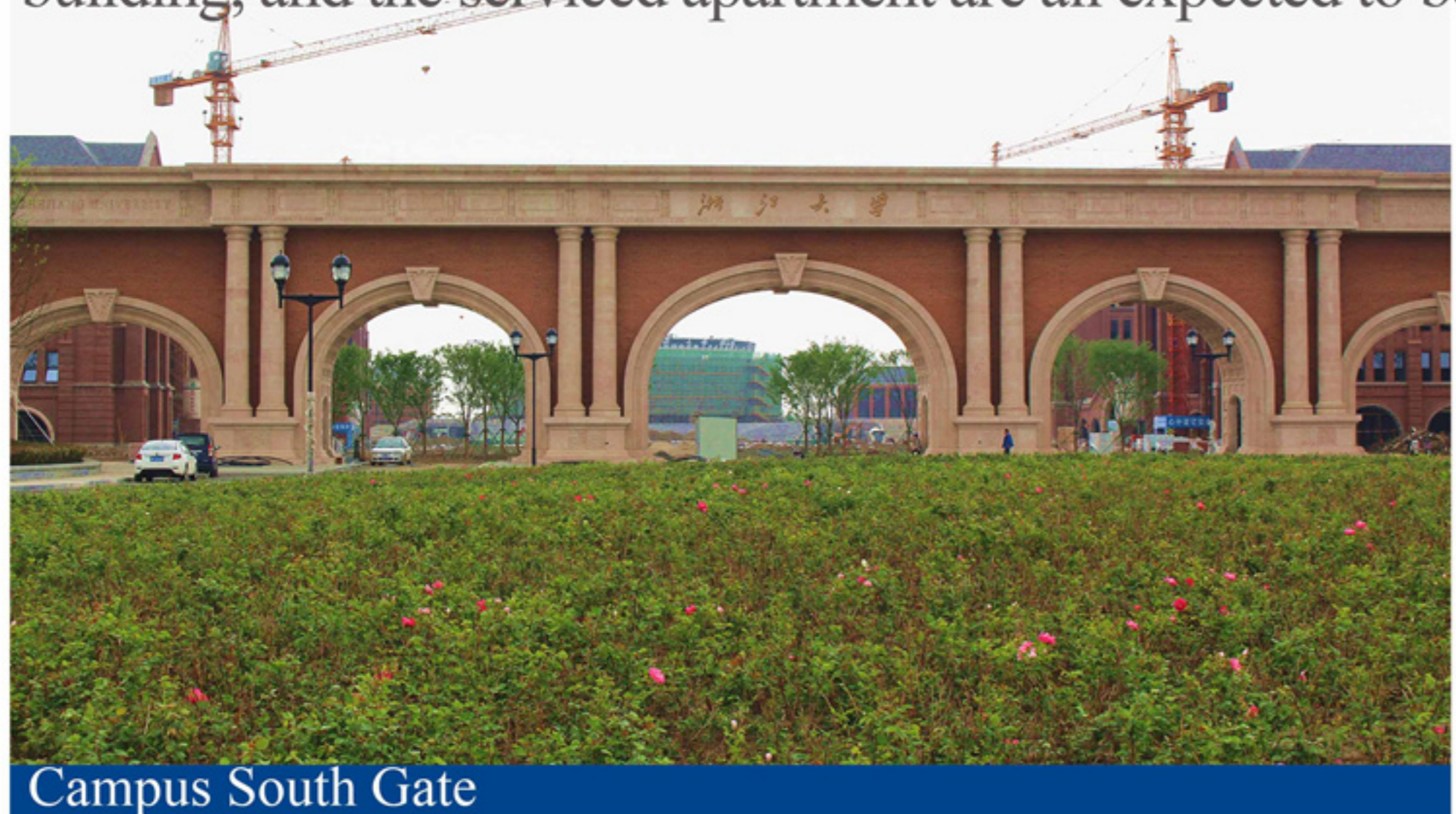

## PHASE TWO Construction Progress of Campus Phase Two



By the middle of May, 2017, the scaffold has been removed from almost all the buildings of the second phase (except the auditorium). The buildings are at an inner construction phase including cable wiring. Additionally, the lake is basically formed as well as the arch bridge. The separating fence in the campus will be removed in September, and by then, the multimedia halls, the auditorium, the new residential college, the ZJU-UIUC Institute /Interdisciplinary research building, the ZJU-UoE Institute/Laboratory building, and the serviced apartment are all expected to be opened.







## Inspection of campus security services and facilities

On 28 April, the Office of Campus Development and Management (CDM), together with Campus Service Center (CSC), Campus Diner Center (CDC), Dormitory Management Office of Residential College, and Campus Clinic, carried out an inspection of campus security service, facilities, and other campus logistics services.

The inspection mainly focused on the following aspects: food safety, venues, campus clinic, CSC, campus security and facilities. During the inspection, many questions were found, discussed and then solved. Due to this inspection, CDM and other logistics service group gained a more comprehensive understanding of the overall situation of the campus, which allows for a sounder logistics service system.



## Campus Comprehensive Service Plan Meeting Held by CDM



On May 11, the campus comprehensive services plan meeting, participated by the representatives of campus institutes and departments and four international students, was held by the Office of Campus Development and Management (CDM) and Campus Service Center(CSC), with the purpose of providing a more complete and reasonable campus service for overall use of International Campus in September 2017. The CSC manager elaborated the campus service plan at the meeting, including service scope, the service content, the distribution of service capital, and other related information. The suggestions and demands from campus institutes, departments and students were presented at the meeting after the brief introduction of the service plan. Questions and opinions were meticulously answered by the head of CDM, CSC, Housing Office of Residential College, Campus Dining Center and Campus Clinic. All the problems were discussed to seek a most reasonable solution. At this meeting, the teachers and students had more comprehensive and in-depth understanding of campus service and they knew more services that might be overlooked before. Besides, the CDM and service departments had a more direct understanding of teachers and students' needs and ideas.
